#SIITR25 has been designed specifically for people who create and invest in social impact in regional Australian communities.

The audience will comprise of regionally focused changemakers who work or volunteer as not for profit managers or board members, social entrepreneurs, social impact investors and policy makers.

#SIITR25 will be held in Grafton, NSW between 3-5 September 2025.

In 2025 our host community is Grafton which is nestled in the beautiful Clarence Valley, NSW. #SIITR25 provides a great opportunity for the Clarence Valley to show off.

We have designed the conference to maximise both economic and social impact in the local community applying the following strategies:

- Location: The conference will be held in the Grafton CBD ensuring delegates visit local cafes and restaurants and have time to visit local retail outlets.
- Local promotion: There are numerous opportunities for local businesses to be promoted throughout the conference. We are also encouraging people to stay in the Clarence and not travel to other major retail centres such as Coffs Harbour.
- Local spend: Most of the conference budget is spent locally ensuring local farmers, hospitality businesses, artists and venues received funding.
- Low waste and reduced food miles: Wherever possible local caterers are sourcing local produce for the conference and also ensuring waste is minimised through recycling, reusing and repurposing.
- **Capability development and community engagement**: Ready Communities is a 24month community engagement and capability development program which leads into, and out of the conference. The local program is called Ready Clarence.

#SIITR25 is deeply embedded in the host community via the Ready Communities program enabling a range of locally led activities from case studies and site visits to sharing local wisdom. The program will follow the same format as 2024 (right side of page) with refreshed themes and streams.

2025 event structure

Theme: As you were Key note and panel followed by workshops. Conference gala dinner at secret venue.
